For almost 20 years, Nadine D. Head has been dedicated to serving her community and advocating for the residents of the Cuyahoga Metropolitan Housing Authority (CMHA). Ms. Head is Vice President of the Progressive Action Council (PAC) for CMHA, which is the 7th largest housing authority in the nation with close to 10,500 units of housing. She helps CMHA's efforts in their mission to be a leader in providing safe, quality, affordable housing opportunities to residents of Cuyahoga County. As the current Vice President of the PAC, she helps lead the team of PAC members to be the voice of the residents and communicate pressing issues and concerns in a way that CMHA management can understand in the hopes of creating viable solutions. Her commitment and consistency have helped her to build a trusting relationship between both residents and CMHA staff; this trust has made her a point person for providing recommendations and suggestions regarding CMHA community affairs. Ms. Head's relationship with CMHA began in 1991 when she moved into Heritage View Homes.

Ms. Head has served on the PAC Executive Committee for ten years. During that time, she held various roles and positions including Financial Secretary in 2006 and Vice President for two terms. Before PAC, she served as the Local Advisory Council (LAC) President for Heritage View Homes for eight years. In her current role as PAC Vice President, Ms. Head holds the 4th Saturday meetings, board meetings, assumes administrative duties, and provides outreach to the residents.

In addition, Ms. Head holds the elder position in her church, Christ Kingdom Ministries under the Bishop. She leads church services and ministers to the members. She is also a member of the Institutional Baptist Church, volunteers at the women's prison to do outreach, and helps the Cleveland Foodbank give out food twice a month through her church.

"I am proud to serve my community and to be a voice for the residents. I hope to improve the lives of others and continue to make CMHA a great place to call home," says Ms. Head. "It is important to me to help others strive for success."
