Why should I choose Griot Village?

Griot Village offers a supportive environment for grandparents and other senior adults raising children.

Who is eligible to apply?

Individuals ages 55 and over who have legal custody of a child or children under the age of 18.

What type of housing is Griot Village?

Griot Village is a Project-Based Voucher housing estate managed by CMHA. These 2, 3, and 4 bedroom units feature garages, in-suite laundry, homework stations for children, and an onsite community center. The development is located just blocks from public transportation, schools, healthcare facilities as well as recreational and cultural centers.

What is Project -Based Voucher housing?

Project-Based Voucher housing is a subsidized housing program where CMHA provides rental payment assistance on behalf of low-income families.
